**Sub: Two Levels of Mathematics**

Dear Parent,

As per the guidelines given in CBSE Circular F.1002/CBSE/Dir(Acad)/ Mathematics/2019 (**Circular No Acad-03/2019**) dated 10th January 2019, henceforth, two levels of Examination will be held in the subject of Mathematics in the Board examination for Class X from the academic session ending March 2020.

The nomenclature for the two Examinations will be Mathematics Standard (041) and Mathematics-Basic (241). Although the syllabus, classroom teaching and internal assessment for both exams will remain the same, the difficulty level for the exam will be different. Mathematics-Basic will be the easier level of examination.

Mathematics Standard will be meant for students who wish to pursue Mathematics in their Senior Secondary level whereas Mathematics Basic will be for the students who are not keen on pursuing Mathematics at the Senior Secondary level. However, according to the CBSE circular, in case a student clears the Mathematics-Basic Exam in the Board exam and desires to pursue Mathematics at Senior Secondary level, she/he shall be given an option to appear in Mathematics-Standard at the time of Compartment exams. Please note that the students will need to choose between the two levels of Examination in August 2022 when the List of Candidates appearing in Class X Board Examination 2024 will be submitted to CBSE by the school.

We request you to guide your ward to choose the level of examination, keeping in mind her / his aptitude for Mathematics and the stream she / he wishes to select in Class XI.
